# **Food Insecurity** on the Sunshine Coast

FOOD INSECURITY IS BROADLY UNDERSTOOD TO BE THE CONDITION OF NOT HAVING ACCESS TO SUFFICIENT FOOD, OR FOOD OF A SUFFICIENT QUALITY, TO MEET ONE'S BASIC NEEDS. WHILE LOCAL LEVEL DATA IS CHALLENGING TO FIND, IN BRITISH COLUMBIA, FOOD INSECURITY STANDS AT AROUND 15%.

The main driver of food insecurity is poverty and there is widespread recognition of the need for enhanced advocacy for income based solutions.

While most people interpret Food Bank Usage as the main indicator of food insecurity, research consistently shows that less than 30% of individuals facing this challenge utilize the food bank. Others simply manage in different ways.

As a result, increasing and diversifying the range of food access points (beyond the traditional food bank model) helps meet more people's needs and helps meet them where they are at. This guide can help service providers and individuals find out where those food resources are.
