



# Community Housing

## LOWER SUNSHINE COAST

A diverse inventory of affordable, appropriate, and safe housing is a foundational component of a thriving community.

This guide offers an overview of affordable and below-market housing, including seniors housing options on the lower Sunshine Coast.



## Community Housing on the Sunshine Coast

COMMUNITY HOUSING REFERS TO AFFORDABLE HOUSING THAT IS OFFERED AT LOW OR VERY LOW RENTAL RATES.

It includes units that are 'subsidized' by BC Housing, where rent is based on income. It also includes housing provided by non-profit organizations at a reduced rate, called 'below-market' housing. Some housing providers offer a 'mixed model' which means that the housing complex includes subsidized, below-market, and 'market rate' rental units. Market rate is a fixed rate not based on the amount of income. Community housing is usually independent living and does not offer support services for residents.

### RENTAL APPLICATIONS

#### Subsidized Housing

Apply directly to the non-profit organization listing the rental or to the BC Housing Registry for BC Housing Properties.

## Seniors Housing

ON THE SUNSHINE COAST, THERE ARE DIFFERENT SENIORS' LIVING AND WELLNESS OPTIONS, FROM AGING AT HOME TO FULLY SUPPORTED CARE.

**Independent Living** is a good option for seniors who are confident in their ability to live alone safely and who want the autonomy to decide the type of support or interaction they want. Below-market independent living units are listed under the previous section (Community Housing).

**Assisted Living Homes** are for seniors who can still live independently and make decisions for themselves, but who require additional support due to physical or health challenges. Assisted living services provide housing, meals, housekeeping, and personal care services.

**Long-Term Care** is an option for seniors who require 24-hour professional support and care because of their physical or health needs or because of advanced dementia.

**Home Care Support** options help seniors receive the assistance they need at home. Services vary from publicly subsidized care through Vancouver Coastal Health, to care provided by non-profit organizations with fees based on a sliding scale, to private pay options. These services can include medical care, transportation, companionship, and housekeeping. This guide only covers public and non-profit home care support.
